


Map of Scam Jam Location

LAWRENCE WASDEN, Idaho Attorney General
Attorney General Wasden is a 25-year veteran of the Office of the Attorney General and a leader in the national effort to protect children from Internet sexual predators. He is a strong advocate for crime victims' rights who has worked to help victims break the cycle of domestic violence. A firm and fair prosecutor, Mr. Wasden is known for his even-handed approach in public corruption cases. Strongly committed to open government, he works to educate Idahoans regarding the state's open meeting and public records laws. Attorney General Wasden's advocacy for senior citizens has led to better laws, giving Idahoans more control over their health care at the end of life.
