Legacy Corps is an award-winning AmeriCorps service project focused on growing the availability of volunteer-based caregiver support for veterans and military families. The program operates in 17 sites across 11 states, and FIA is thrilled to be bringing Legacy Corps to Idaho!

We are recruiting Legacy Corps volunteers and seek your help.

Legacy Corps volunteers commit to one year of service---each Legacy Corps volunteer will provide 450 hours of caregiver respite and support to veterans throughout the year. In exchange for that year-long commitment, volunteers receive extensive training (90 hours!); a living allowance; and an education award at the end of their year of service.
