FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS (FAQ)

Qualifications or Requirements

FAQ1: What are the eligibility requirements for Case Management?

- Eligibility is based on the following:
 - o Must be 60 years old or older
 - o Require minimal assistance with one or more ADLs or IADLs;
 - o Require services from multiple health/social services providers; and
 - o Are unable to obtain the required health/social services for themselves; or
 - o Lack available formal or informal supports that can provide the needed assistance.

FAQ1: What are ADLs and IADLs?

- ADLs and IADLs are part of a comprehensive assessment used to identify the service needs of an individual:
 - o ADLs (Activities of Daily Living) are bathing, dressing, toileting, transferring, eating, and walking.
 - IADLs (Instrumental Activities of Daily Living) are meal preparation, money management, transportation, shopping, using the telephone, medication management, heavy housework, and light housework.
