- Discussed the continued effort to stay on track with the Strategic and State plan goals.

 - Every Four Years Idaho must submit a State Plan for ACL approval meeting the guidance requirements.

 - Yearly AAA create a budget.
 - Quarterly ICOA issues budget updates/guidance.
 - Monthly AAA manage service units within budget. ICOA reimburses allowable expenses.

APS / Community Care Project – Deedra Hunt, Lynn Fyanes, and Janet Miller

- Lynn presented on APS/ Community project timeline:
 - 2018 2021 Alzheimer's Disease and Related Dementia (ADSSP) grant was piloted to increase dementia capability across the state to include evidenced-based Powerful Tools for Caregivers workshops, locally developed dementia skills training, testing person-centered caregiver assessments and consumer-directed respite for caregivers.
 - 2020-present: The Lifespan grant allowed ICOA and AAAs to expand and evaluate the consumer-directed respite across the state.
 - 2022 Caregiver Community Care Project: Lessons learned demonstrated the need for a more cost-effective, comprehensive, far-reaching, No-Wrong Door approach for caregivers to include hiring and training Community Health Managers and Community Health Advocates to focus on expanding training and development of the number of CHA / public health professionals within the aging and disability networks to support the public health of older adults and people with disabilities.
 - Janet Presented on:
 - CDR Homemaker, Chore, and transportation services.
 - Goals to expand, enhance, and improve access to CDR homemaker, chore, and transportation services throughout Idaho.
 - Deedra presented on:
 - Area 3 APS Caregiver Care Coordination project will support the development and pilot of the Caregiver Community Care project until July 31, 2024.
 - When all is done, APS workers will have a new statewide resource available to help reduce risk to vulnerable adults.

- APS workers will make appropriate referrals of family caregivers of APS clients to the Caregiver Community Care service for caregiver relief.
- Overwhelmed caregivers will be identified through the normal line of APS work.
- Ultimately this work will be rolled up and recognized as the Caregiver Community Care service.
